



16 Classes for Adults and High School Students

All 16 topics will be offered during all 4 class times. One class, "Recognizing Sexual Predators" is a longer curriculum and will take up two class times, one starting at 10:00am and the other at 1:00pm. This class is recommended for adults only. High school students will only be allowed to attend with a parent/guardian.

Teen Extreme (5th- 8th Graders):

The Teen Extreme is very popular and space in the crime lab class will be limited. One group will get the lab portion in the morning, while the other half will attend the "Internet Safety for Teens" and "Ask a Police Officer" classes. The two groups will rotate after lunch. **Due to the limited space in the crime lab class, if your teen would like to reserve a space, please indicate class "A" for 9:30am-11:45am or class "B" for 1:00pm-2:45pm on the registration page.** Teens who attend all 3 classes will receive a free t-shirt. These classes will be taught by police personnel and the teens will be supervised, except for during the lunch break. Parents will have lunch with their teens and return them to attend afternoon classes. A security system will be in place to ensure the security of releasing children only to the registered parent/guardian. Parent/guardian must remain on premise.

KidZone (K – 4th Graders):

KidZone is a station-style program with 12 stations. The children will be supervised, so parents are free to attend the adult classes. The children will spend 15-20 min per station. They will get to have a passport stamped at each station they attend and if they attend at least 6 stations (half of the day), they will receive a free Prevention Convention t-shirt. Children staying all day, and completing all 12 stations, will be eligible for a drawing for a great prize. Parents will have lunch with their children and return them to attend afternoon rotations. A security system will be in place to ensure the security of releasing children only to the registered parent/guardian. Parent/guardian must remain on premise.
